

Meeting Minutes

Menchville HS Football Parent Support Group

June 7, 2010

The meeting was held at Menchville Baptist Church.

In attendance: Joann Sullivan, Kathy Lennartz, Angela Weeks, Ann Maitland, Terry Bimler, Kimberly Swanson, and Marie Hall.

The meeting began at 6:33 p.m. with a welcome from PSG 1st Vice President, Kathy Lennartz. Agendas and copies of last year's by-laws was given to each person in attendance.

There were no minutes recorded for the last meeting of the 2009 season.

Joann Sullivan presented the treasurer's report. There is a balance of \$725.83 in the MHS Parent Support Group account. Dan Sullivan has received \$300 in donation for businesses that will advertise on the MHS Football website.

Kathy gave a brief history of the PSG to new attendees. This included the traditional expenditures of: the spirit packs (t-shirts and shorts for the players for practices), the annual team and family kick-off picnic, refreshments for two-a-days, support of homecoming activities, and the banquet.

The by-laws were presented. At the next meeting, the by-laws will be approved for the 2010 season. Kathy explained the duties of the board members as new members will need to be elected. This will be discussed, and perhaps voted on at the next meeting. Kathy stated that there is good parent support so the executive board positions are not daunting.

Upcoming events were discussed. Marie Hall is the manager at the Miller Mart in the Kiln Creek shopping complex. (This is the one with Super K, Chicago Uno, Chick-Fil-A, etc.) She gave dates that car washes could be done. She stated that car washes there bring in large donations for school groups. The Newport News side of Kiln Creek is zoned for Menchville which makes this location a good one. Kathy stated that parent volunteers are needed for car washes. Dates scheduled with Marie are: June 19th, July 11th, 18th and 25th. The last three dates are Sundays as Saturdays are booked.

A brief reminder that the Bethel camp dates were changed was given.

Kathy explained that Coach Byron had a team and family picnic prior to the beginning of practice. The PSG has provided the hamburgers, hot dogs, and drinks. Kathy said she would ask Coach Byron for dates and would check on availabilities of shelters at NN city parks. Terry Bimler said she would check with the Moose Lodge on Warwick to see if we could use their facilities.

Preparation for the next meeting: the need for parents to serve on the executive board (a vote must be held); revision/approval of by-laws, determining budget expenditures, and committee formation.

Angela Weeks said she would like to have a committee to for J.V. players and parents. The purpose

would be to gather and disseminate information and provide snacks for players prior to Monday J.V. games. Angela stated that snacks were provided last season at the expense of Joann Sullivan with small donations from other parents. Kathy agreed that this would be a good committee.

The next meeting date was set for June 14th at 6:30 p.m. at Menchville Baptist Church.
