

Minutes of PSG
October 6, 2011

The members of the Parent Support Group met on October 6, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. at Menchville Baptist Church. A list of those in attendance is attached.

Welcome

President Terry Bimler welcomed everyone present. She reviewed the minutes of the last meeting and called for a motion for approval. Joann Sullivan provided the motion, seconded by Kelly Lamb and the minutes were approved by unanimous vote.

Treasurer's Report

Joann Sullivan reported a balance of \$3,320.17 which included deposits for t-shirt sales, the Chick-fil-A fundraiser and donations. It was noted that \$2,000 is to be set aside for the banquet.

Old Business

President Bimler noted that the Adopt-A-Player program went well this year but should be begun earlier next year. Norma Green was asked to get the names of those who participated and draft a thank you note. Terry requested \$75 to reimburse her for goodie bags she made for the Adopt-A-Player program.

Banquet

The discussion moved to the banquet and it was decided that the Adopt-A-Player participants would be invited to the football banquet and they could bring one guest. Their cost was set at \$15. It was also decided that everyone must RSVP at the link provided on the website and all monies paid in advance (no money will be taken at the door). The coaches and players are free of charge.

Beverley Mueller was requested to write a letter to the supporters inviting them to the banquet. Dalithea Smalls will get the deadline for the RSVP from Golden Corral. Terry Bimler reminded everyone that the church requires a \$50 AV fee and a \$50 custodian fee. Terry said that she would be in charge of getting plaques and gifts for the banquet and Kelly would take responsibility for getting the seniors names for senior night awards.

The banquet time was set from 5:00-9:00pm with set up beginning at noon. Dalithea Smalls will get with the Church to work out set up and will arrange for volunteers to be food servers. JJ Foster will be in charge of center pieces. Rolls of purple and gold table cloths will be purchased.

Continuing Business

Terry Bimler noted that she had 16 t-shirts remaining to be sold. No new t-shirt orders are being taken.

The game day food arrangements were clarified for the remainder of the year. On Saturday games the team eats at the Church at 11:00am and 5:00pm on Friday game days at school.

To date 44 memberships to the PSG have been paid.

Another Chick-fil-A Spirit Night was set for November 1st and Terry Bimler noted that the team needs the coaches' support at these fundraisers.

Coach Moore announced that the team was invited to Menchville Baptist Church the Sunday following the last game, November 6th at 9:00 am. The boys should wear their jersey with a dress shirt.
